Piggly Wiggly is an American supermarket chain that operates in the southern and midwestern regions of the United States, run by Piggly Wiggly, LLC, a subsidiary of C&S Wholesale Grocery Stores. [1] Its first outing opened in 1916 in Memphis, Tennessee, and is notable for the fact that it was the first true self-service grocery store, and the creator of several well-known supermarket features such as check stands, individual item price marking and shopping carts. The company's current headquarters are in Keene, New Hampshire. [2] More than 600 independently owned Piggly Wiggly stores operate in 17 states, primarily in smaller towns and cities. [3] It was founded on September 6, 1916[4] (although it did not open until five days later due to delays in construction).[5] at 79 Jefferson Avenue in Memphis, Tennessee, by Clarence Saunders. [2] A copy of the original store has been constructed at the Memphis Museum and Planetarium, a mansion that Saunders built as his private residence, which was later sold in the city. At the time of its establishment, grocery stores did not allow their customers to collect their own goods. Instead, a customer would give a list of items to an employee, who would then pass by the store, gathering them. This created a higher cost, and therefore higher prices. Piggly Wiggly introduced the innovation of allowing customers to go through the store, assembling their own products, thus reducing costs and lowering prices. [2] Losses due to easier shoplifting were more than offset by gains from the growth of the impulse market. Others were initially experimenting with this form as well, which initially became known as groceria, reminding people of cafes, another relatively new, self-service idea. [6] Piggly Wiggly secured the form of self-service and issued franchises to hundreds of grocery retailers to operate its stores. The concept of self-contained shop was patented[7] by Saunders in 1917. Customers at Piggly Wiggly entered the store through a and walked through four aisles to see the store's 605 items sold in packages and organized into sections. Customers chose merchandise as they continued through the maze at the till. Immediately, brand packaging and recognition became important for businesses and consumers. [9] Piggly Wiggly's success was unprecedented, so much so that other independent and chain groceries switched to self-service in the 1920s and 1930s. At its peak in 1932 (see Clarence Saunders), the company operated 2,660 stores and posted annual sales of more than \$180 million. In November 1922, Saunders attempted a squeeze on the significant short interest in the stock, running the share price from 40 to 120 and profits by millions on paper. Stock market administrators responded by ruling that a corner had been established in Piggly Wiggly and removed the stock from the board, eventually forcing Saunders to hand over his assets to banks that had funded his leveraged position. Saunders reportedly lost \$9 million in the attempt. [10] After these events, the company was divided into strategic units and sold to regional grocery chains, including Kroger, Safeway, National Tea, and Colonial. [11] In 1935, all 179 Canadian Piggly Wiggly were also sold to Canada Safeway, which merged with Sobeys in 2013. [12] After losing control of Piggly Wiggly, Saunders had no further connection to the company, although he remained interested in the concept of automated shopping, with which he first experimented with the Kedoozle store until his death in 1953. [2] According to John Brooks, Piggly Wiggly's much changed corporate structure... it flourished in the 1960s, and hundreds of stores operated under a franchise agreement with the Piggly Wiggly Corporation, of Jacksonville, Florida. [13] Name According to the Piggly Wiggly website, Saunders was reluctant to explain the origin of the company name. There are two theories: A story says that while riding a train, he looked out of his window and saw several small pigs struggling to get under a fence, which prompted him to think of rhyme. Someone once asked him why he had chosen such an unusual name for his organization, to which he replied, so people would ask that exact question. [2] This piggly wiggly company was acquired by wholesale grocer Malone & Hyde in 1982. [14] Malone & Hyde was acquired by Fleming Companies in 1988. [15] Fleming filed for bankruptcy in 2003 and C&S Wholesale Grocers acquired most of the business, including Piggly Wiggly. [16] [17] A Piggly Wiggly store in Springhill, Louisiana, in August 2011 There are now more than 600 independently owned and operated stores in 17 states. The company's headquarters are located in New Hampshire. [2] Some of the stores have formed a retailer cooperative to manage distribution, using the name Wiggly Wiggly (e.g., Piggly Wiggly Midwest and Piggly Wiggly Alabama distributing business). Piggly Wiggly stores are mainly located in medium to smaller cities, and remain a fixture in many rural communities. In In From the largest cities and most metropolitan areas within the company's territory (especially in the fastest growing regions), competitive national grocery chains have built larger supermarkets with greater variety and choice than Piggly Wiggly, aiming for a more classy clientele. In response, Piggly Wiggly was one of the first to develop a loyalty card discount member program similar to many other national merchants.
